

DELINQUENT TAX LIST

For Weber County, Utah, For the Year 1900.

Pursuant to Section 2630 of the Revised Statutes of Utah, 1898, and the authority vested in me by said section, I, the undersigned, Alma D. Chambers, Treasurer of Weber County, hereby give public notice that the following named persons are delinquent in payment of State, State School, County, County School, Special School, City and City School taxes for the year 1900, to the amounts set opposite their respective names, on the property indicated, reference being hereby made to the assessment rolls of said county, now in my law, up the whole amount of delinquent taxes, which go to make forth, and the same is hereby made a part of this notice. Unless said amounts, together with the costs accrued are sooner paid by the delinquent taxpayers, I shall sell sufficient of such delinquent real estate to pay the taxes and costs, at public auction, to the highest responsible bidder, for cash, in the manner prescribed by law.

Said sale will begin on the third Monday of December (17th) at 12 o'clock m., at the front door of the County Court House, Ogden, Utah, and will continue from day to day until the property of said delinquents is exhausted, or the taxes and costs paid.
